

Update of recently reported incidents

**Notton**

**26/6/20**

**George Lane:** Overnight 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup>, entry gained to domestic garage through window. A Makhita power drill and jigsaw stolen together with a Santa Cruz mountain bike in turquoise and cream.

**Ryhill**

**8/6/20**

**Mulberry Place:** About 2am, offenders enter complainants garden by breaking lock on gate. Enters unsecured summerhouse and steal a Boardman MTR mountain bike in grey. Three, believed males with hooded tops and faces covered responsible.

**Cliffe Road:** Between 3am and 7:15am, entry gained to domestic garage by breaking through roof. Carrea mountain bike stolen and cloths stolen from washing line.

During same time frame the garage at a further garage was entered by removing glass pane from widow. Numerous household power tools stolen together with golfing equipment.
