**Sandal**

**7/5/20**

**Woolgreaves Croft:** Between 7<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup>, persons unseen enter complainant's drive and cause damage to bonnet and wing of parked secured vehicle.

**11/5/20**

**Slack Lane.** About 00:45am complainant was awoken by garage alarm activating. Upon checking discovered lock in garage door had been forced and two pedal cycles stolen. A Trek pedal cycle and a Voodoo mountain bike.
